Age Groups & Handicap Divisions

Minimum 18 divisions – you are guaranteed to play with golfers your own age and standard. The handicap range for each grade will be determined by entries.

35-49 A,B,C grade (max h'cap 30 men; 40 ladies)

50-59 A,B,C grade (max h'cap 30 men; 40 ladies)

60-69 A,B,C grade (max h'cap 36 men; 45 ladies)

70+ A,B,C grade (max h'cap 36 men; 45 ladies)

In partnership with Golf Link and International Golf Associations, the tournament committee will review the 6 month playing history of all entrants. The tournament committee reserves the right to amend player handicaps prior to and during the tournament.

Pace of Play

For the enjoyment of all players, field sizes will be limited and there will be on-course marshalling. Tips to improve pace of play will be provided.

Motorised Carts

Use of a motorised cart is restricted to those with a medical certificate and over 70's. Cart numbers are limited and will be issued on a first come, first served basis. Four round hire cost is \$100 and must be paid with your entry deposit.
