DAY 1 Arrive in Casablanca, Morocco

12 Feb, 2024

Welcome to Casablanca! Just like the film, Casablanca, this place is culturally, historically, and aesthetically significant. A port city and commercial hub, fronting the Atlantic Ocean. The city's French colonial legacy is seen in its downtown Mauresque architecture, a blend of Moorish style and European art deco. Standing partly over the water, the enormous Hassan II Mosque, completed in 1993, has a 210m minaret topped with lasers directed toward Mecca. You'll be delivered to your hotel and given time to rest before we all come together for welcome drinks.

DAY 2: Casablanca, Morocco We waste no time in jumping into our first adventure after breakfast, with the whole group enjoying a day of sightseeing in the city of Casablanca. This will be a guided tour and we will be visiting some of the main tourist attractions of the economic capital of Morocco including, **Bab Marrakech**, **Aïn Diab Corniche**, **Central Market**, **Habous Quarter**, and a panoramic visit of the huge **Hassan II Mosque** (from outside). You'll be transferred back to your hotel and given time to relax before we all come together for dinner and drinks.

DAY 3: Casablanca, Morocco After breakfast the **golfers** will be transferred to their first golf course:

A BLEND OF LUXURY AND URBAN SPACES: Tony Jacklin Casablanca Golf Course. Tony Jacklin, one of the greatest golfers in history as a player and also leader of the European and British Ryder Cup teams, has created this beautiful golf course. The natural areas and the 10 artificial lakes fit perfectly into the design of the course. 18 championship holes, Par 72, 5575 meters long, run alongside the Bouskoura forest and wind through lush vegetation.

The **non-golfers** will enjoy a shopping tour today. Visiting the **Morocco Mall** and **New Town**. Morocco Mall is spread over 250,000m2 and contains more than 163 stores.

A majestic aquarium, the 3rd largest in the world, stands in the center of the mall, a musical fountain, the fourth largest in the world, is also must-see.

DAY 4: Casablanca to Rabat

Breakfast will be served before a day at your leisure, to explore **Rabat**. The town rests along the shores of the **Bouregreg River** and the Atlantic Ocean. It's known for landmarks that speak to its Islamic and French-colonial heritage, including the **Kasbah of the Udayas**. This Berber-era royal fort is surrounded by formal French-designed gardens and overlooks the ocean. The city's iconic **Hassan Tower**, a 12th-century minaret, soars above the ruins of a mosque. There is plenty to see and do here with markets, a myriad of culinary options and immersive cultural diversity and history to experience. You will have the evening at leisure.

## DAY 5: Rabat, Morocco

After breakfast, the golfers will be transferred to the **Royal Golf Dar Es Salam** course for the day:

#### A GOLFING MASTERPIECE: Royal Golf Dar Es Salam - Blue Course

Dar Es Salam Royal Golf Club's Blue Course is known for its variety, hiding its greens behind doglegs and fairway turns. The 18-hole Robert Trent Jones-designed golf course is part of the 45-hole Dar Es Salam layout. The Blue Course can turn into a long run as well. One example is No. 11, a par-4 hole known for its beauty and difficulty. Trees and brambles narrow the fairway, which is flanked by a lake with two large mimosa trees.

**Non-golfers** will be out sightseeing along the **Coastal Road**, **Hay Riad**. From **Andalusian Gardens** to **The Royal Palaca of Rabat** - there is so much to see and experience!

## Day 6: Rabat, Morocco

After breakfast, the golfers will head back **Royal Golf Dar Es Salam** for their second round of golf at this course, teeing off on the **Red Course** today.

#### THE CROWN JEWEL: Royal Golf Dar Es Salam - Red Course

Dar Es Salam Royal Golf Club's Red Course is the *crown jewel* of the three golf courses on the property. The Robert Trent Jones design has been rated in the top 100 golf courses in the world. It is a long golf course, set in a forest of cork, oak and eucalyptus trees, with gently rolling terrain and some water in play. The ninth hole is well known for the large lake with the green in its center.

Non-Golfers, will spend the day on a guided Medina & Oudaya Tour.

Day 7: Rabat to Marrakech, Morocco This morning, we'll have our breakfast before transferring to **Marrakech and will have** the afternoon to explore or relax.

The Royal Golf Marrakech entrusts the extension of 9 holes to two french designers: Gert Watine, a golf professional who was born in Morocco and Thierry Sprecher, an architect who constructed many golfs in the hexagon. It is on this course that you will discover one of the most famous holes, the "Brigitte Bardot".

Non-Golfers: Moroccan Cooking Workshop

Start the day with a short Arabic lesson before heading off to the market to test your new language skills while buying fresh produce. Then discover the secrets to the various spices and ingredients used in **Moroccan cooking** while learning to make Moroccan salads, tajines or couscous. Feast on your cuisine.

DAY 9: Marrakech, Morocco After breakfast, we will have a guided city tour of Marrakech, Medina & Souks. The tour includes lunch & visiting historical monuments. #### THE NEWEST "MUST PLAY" GOLF COURSE IN MOROCCO: Assoufid Golf Course

Assoufid Golf Club's design vision was to create a desert-style course, integrated into the unique existing landscape while maximizing the scenic views of the Atlas Mountains to the south. Designed by former European Tour player, Niall Cameron, the golf course takes into consideration its environmental impact through minimal water consumption and the preservation of native plants and trees.

**Non-Golfers,** will enjoy an exciting excursion to **Ourika Valley** in the foot hills of **Atlas Mountains.** The Ourika River flows through the valley and there are many villages inhabited by **Berber tribes**. There is a group of waterfalls tucked away behind the village of **Setti Fatma**. This group of waterfalls with its cool water is one of the highlights of the **Ourika Valley.** 

Dinner will be with show at the **JAD MAHAL Restaurant** in Marrakech including drinks. Immerse yourself in wonderful French and Moroccan cuisines. Get your meal started with delicious wine, fino sherry or liqueur. You may come across reviews that chocolate frappe is great here. Live music is performed by musicians in the evening. The hospitable staff reflects the style and character of Jad Mahal. The spectacular decor and lovely ambiance let guests feel relaxed to enjoy everything on offer.

Day 11: Marrakech to Agadir, Morocco After an indulgent breakfast we are transferred to **Agadir**.

We will stop for lunch at our en-route sightseeing to **Essaouira**. Essaouira is a port city and resort on Morocco's Atlantic coast. Its medina (old town) is protected by 18th-century seafront ramparts called the **Skala de la Kasbah**, which were designed by European engineers. Old brass cannons line the walls, and there are ocean views. Strong "Alizée" trade winds make the city's crescent beach popular for surfing, windsurfing and kitesurfing.

## DAY 12: Agadir, Morocco

The **non-golfers** will visit the **Argan oil Cooperative**. We will enjoy a scenic walk back to the hotel and have the evening at your leisure.




