## DAY 4: Barcelona to Granada, Spain

We farewell Barcelona taking a **scenic flight to Granada** in the **Sierra Nevada**, capital of the Moorish kingdom until 1492. Within 100 metres of the beach and set on one of the most exclusive tracts of land, it is a gorgeous destination to play our wonderful game of golf. The clubhouse oozes tradition with famous golfers' names jumping out at you on the competition boards.

## DAY 7: Marbella, Spain

#### THE OLD COURSE: The San Roque Club

This legendary course is steeped in history, hosting 15 European Tour Schools from 1993-2007 and the Spanish Open in 2005. Some of the greats of the game ignited their careers here and have gone on to win major championships.

Having hosted the Portuguese Open on no fewer than eight occasions, the South Course is regarded as one of Portugal's premier golfing venues.

**Non-golfers** will cruise the captivating **Algarve coast** with it's spectacular cliffs and caves. This evening we'll dine at a **beachside restaurant**.
