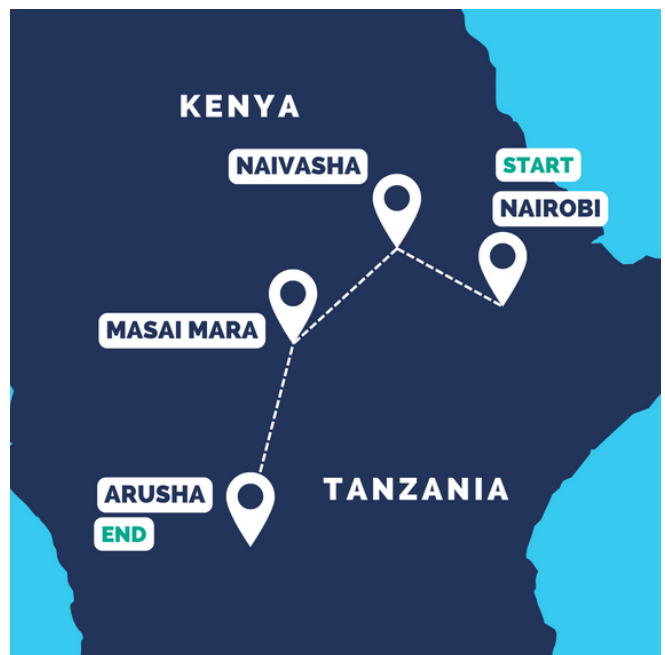
Arguably the greatest wildlife spectacle in **Africa**, the migration of two million wildebeest across the **Serengeti Plains** climaxes with a series of perilous river crossings.

Every year with the changing of the season, the **Serengeti Masai Mara** ecosystem sees over 1.5 million wildebeests and hundreds of thousands of Zebras and Gazelles migrate through the Serengeti and **Masai Mara** in search of food and water. The herds move in a clockwise circle and cover around 2,000 kilometres from the southern expanse of the **Serengeti** and the **Ngorongoro** conservation area over the border of **Kenya** to the **Maasai Mara**, back down to south **Serengeti**. During this time, they give birth, brave crocodile-infested waters and fend off hungry predators like Lions, Cheetahs and Leopards.

It is the world's largest and furthest migration of land mammals. This natural phenomenon is listed as one of the **Seven Natural Wonders of Africa**.

Kenya is the historical home of the **East African** safari, a land of sweeping savannah grasslands inhabited by charismatic mega-fauna, including Big Cats, the Big Five and just about everything in between. Elsewhere, landscapes here stir the soul with deserts in the north, dense forests in the west, **Rift Valley** lakes in the center and tropical coast out east.

Tanzania is one of Africa's top safari destinations. The wildlife viewing is out of this world and big cats are especially easy to see. All members of the Big Five can be found in various **Tanzanian** parks and reserves, and all five are present in the **Ngorongoro Crater** and **Serengeti National Park**.

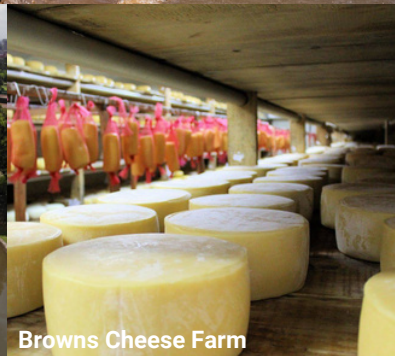

Nairobi, Kenya

The golfers will play their second course today:

#3 IN KENYA: Karen Country Club

*The hallowed fairways of one of the world's most scenic golf courses are a sanctuary for the The Karen Country Club is a family oriented club, founded in 1937 and prides itself in being one of the oldest golf clubs in Kenya. The course is superbly maintained with greens built to the PGA standards. The Club has been host to the prestigious Barclays Kenya Open for the past three consecutive years. Despite Nairobi's temperate climate, you can play golf 365 days a year in comfort, an intangible asset that few golf courses in the world can claim. The setting of the golf course is serene; with the Ngong hills as a backdrop, a rich variety of trees, indigenous forest, flowering shrubs and fauna. The wetlands are a distinct environmental feature of the course and also home to thousands of birds and dik diks. *Caddies Included.*

Non-golfers will have a day filled with adventure and some interesting insights into the world of tea. Just a short drive from the heart of **Nairobi, Kiambethu Farm** at **Limuru** provides a tranquil insight into life on a settler farm. Situated at 7,200 ft., **Kiambethu** was bought and farmed by AB McDonnell in 1910. He was a pioneer in the tea industry being one of the first to make and sell tea commercially in **Kenya** - now one of Kenya's largest exports. Five generations have lived on the farm and it is currently run by his granddaughter Fiona Vernon. The farm house is set within beautiful gardens surrounded by acres of tea and indigenous forest.

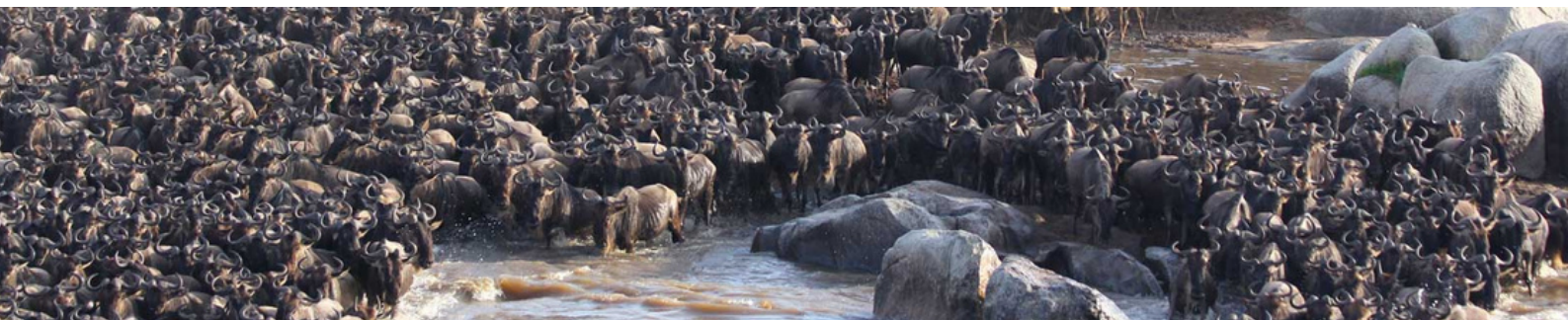
18-HOLE CHAMPIONSHIP COURSE: Great Rift Valley Golf Course - Round 1

Set on the slopes of a small dormant volcano with unspoilt scenery in all directions, most holes on this course enjoy stunning views of mountains, plains, lakes and both escarpments of the Rift Valley itself. The 18-hole course is laid out around the Great Rift Valley Lodge and along the fairways are 80 generously spaced privately owned homes, some of which are let out to hotel guests. *Caddies Included.*

Non-golfers are also in for a treat today! We will visit the **Crescent Island Sanctuary**. One of the most scenic and breathtaking wildlife sanctuaries situated along **Lake Naivasha**, one of the most stunning fresh water lakes in **Kenya**. The island is a peninsula surrounded by the water of **Lake Naivasha** and can only be accessed by boat. Here we will see a variety of wildlife and bird species.

After a busy day, dinner and the evening will be at leisure.

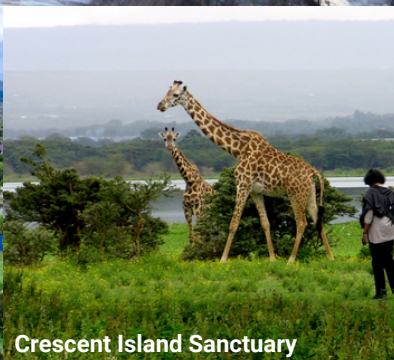

The park is a premium game park, one of only three in the country and one of the most visited game parks in Kenya. **Lake Nakuru Park** is known as bird lover's hub because of the numerous birds that make home in this park. **Lake Nakuru Park** is home to over 400 bird species including the flamingos that live on the lake and in the park's savannah grasslands.

After breakfast we will be transferred to **Masai Mara National Reserve**. We will enjoy lunch en-route, and have a group Sunset Game Drive upon arrival in **Masai Mara National Reserve**. Located in south west Kenya, with a vast scenic expanse of gently rolling African savannah plains, bordering the **Serengeti National Park** in Tanzania to the south. **Masai Mara** is a unique wildlife conservation haven famous for its spectacular natural diversity of wildlife and is the **premier Kenya Safari location** in East Africa, offering visitors numerous reasons to visit this animal paradise. **Large numbers of Lions, Cheetah, Elephant, Rhino, African Buffalo, Wildebeest, Giraffe, Zebra and many more animals** are found in the park in their natural habitat, unconfined and free to roam the vast **Kenyan** wilderness stretching for miles on end.

We check into **Sarova Mara Game Camp**, which offers spacious luxurious "tents" attractively constructed in light beige canvas with large "windows", glass doors and a permanent roof.

Tonight we will have dinner and be treated with traditional dance performances.

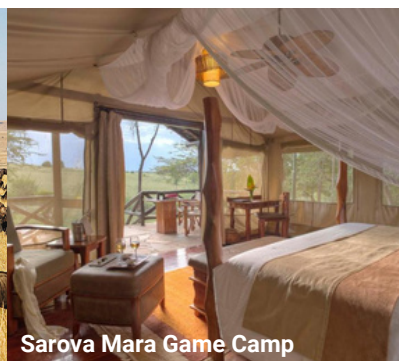

Maasai Mara
National Reserve

For that wild experience, we are doing a **Bush Breakfast** for a chance to enjoy your freshly prepared breakfast, al fresco, in the middle of the plains, surrounded by wildlife, at the banks for **Marra River**, before we head off to our morning game drive. After our game drive we will enjoy lunch back at the resort and relax a bit before we are off to our next sunset game drive.

We will pay a visit to the **Masai Village**. Just as famous as the Serengeti plains, Mount Kilimanjaro, the big five or the Wildebeest migration are the **Masai**, Africa's undoubtedly most famed tribal people. Their brightly coloured wraps, distinctive dance and song as well as the iconic circular bomas are a lifetime memory to hold on.

Hot Air Balloon Experience (Optional Extra*): Drift over the **Maasai Mara** in a hot air balloon as you take in the amazing sunrise and animals below. Your hot air balloon safari is topped off with a magnificent buffet breakfast and champagne. The first pink tongues of sunlight flicker across the skies as the hot air balloon fills, then rises. Suspended in a basket beneath the rainbow-coloured canopy, you will experience a wildlife viewing adventure from an entirely different perspective. Your hot air balloon flight lasts approximately 1 hour and 10 minutes, drifting wherever the air currents take you, with ample opportunities for photography and video filming. When your **Kenyan hot air balloon safari** finishes you will toast your return to earth with a champagne breakfast, cooked wherever you land. Your hour hot air balloon safari ends with a transfer back to your accommodation, in an open Jeep for easier game viewing.

TOM MACAULEY DESIGNED: Windsor Golf Club

This undoubtedly is the best course in Kenya and is said to be the best in Africa for a host of golfing events. The championship design and length of the course is the centre of attention and deservedly so. It threads its way through coffee farms and indigenous forests with high and low terrain, giving it character and design quality. The Golf Course boasts lush, springy fairways, fast, true greens and a sprinkling of attractive water hazards with 73 well located sand bunkers and unforgiving roughs make this course a truly challenging experience. Situated at an altitude of more than a mile above sea level, the ball will travel 10 yards further than at sea level. Even for the non-golfer the course is a beautiful walking experience luxuriating in the wonders of nature with bird life, fish, flora and fauna in abundance.

Non-golfers we will visit the **Sheldrick Wildlife Trust** - one of Africa's oldest wildlife charities and a leading conservation organisation, the **Sheldrick Wildlife Trust (SWT)** embraces all measures that complement the conservation, preservation and protection of wildlife. Working across **Kenya**, the projects include anti-poaching, safeguarding the natural environment, enhancing community awareness, addressing animal welfare issues, providing veterinary assistance to animals in need, rescuing and hand rearing **Elephant and Rhino Orphans**, along with other species that can ultimately enjoy a quality of life. Our last stop for the day will be at the **Giraffe Center**.

DAVID JONES DESIGNED: Kilimanjaro Golf Club - Round 1

*Situated on 1,040 acres of prime African bush land, nestled between Mt Kilimanjaro and Mt Meru. To the south stretches the Maasai Steppe and the great ridges of the ancient Eastern Arc chain: the Pare, Usambara and Blue Mountains, all of which are visible from the estate. The Usa River, an important water source, runs along the western side of the estate. The Kilimanjaro Golf Club is the main feature of the estate, consisting of the first 18-hole championship golf course in Tanzania. Designed by former Irish national coach and Kenya Open champion; David Jones, the club is geared to host international and local golf events, tournaments and club nights. *Caddies Included*

Non-golfers will pay a visit to **Arusha National Park**. There's nowhere else on earth that the transition between a pristine mountainous landscape and a bustling city landscape is as abrupt as it is in **Arusha National Park**. Tucked away in mainland **Tanzania**, this protected park is largely dominated by the imposing **Mt. Meru** and wears the crown of the 'most topographically dynamic and beautiful wildlife parks'. Not only does it shelter the **Ngorongoro Crater** but it is also home to the planet's largest population of African giraffes.

DAY 14:
Arusha, Tanzania

We enjoy breakfast before a full day game drive to the iconic **Lake Manyara National Park**. **Lake Manyara National Park** offers a wilderness experience in diverse habitats, from its **Rift Valley** soda lake to dense woodlands and steep mountainsides. Apart from a spectacular setting, the park is famous for its unusual tree-climbing lions and the vast elephant herds it was established to protect.

The shores of the lake, encrusted with **Pink Flamingo**, attract more than 400 species of birds, many of them waterfowl or migrants. Large herds of **Buffalo, Cheetah, Maasai Giraffe and Impala** roam the lake shores and the forested valley slopes.

A **Lake Manyara** safari is a fascinating experience, as the park also features a ground-water forest, acacia tortilis woodland and hot springs called Maji Moto. Troops of several hundred olive baboon appear alongside **Sykes monkey and short-eared galago**. **Cape clawless otter, Egyptian mongoose, hippo and klipspringer** are other park residents.

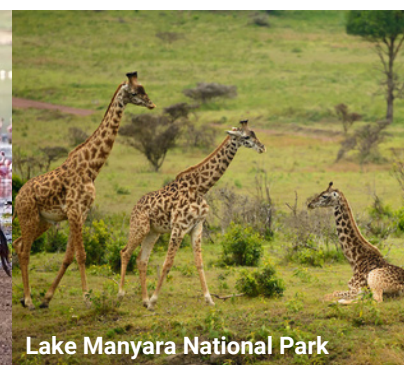

DAVID JONES DESIGNED: Kilimanjaro Golf Club - Round 2

The Kilimanjaro Golf and Wildlife Estate comprises an 18-hole championship golf course together with a real estate development set within an area of outstanding natural beauty. The estate is situated in 1,000 acres of African bush, approximately 25 km from the tourism stopover of Arusha, and a similar distance from Kilimanjaro International Airport.

Non-golfers enjoy the day on a scenic game drive to **Ngorongoro Crater**. The **Ngorongoro Conservation Area** protects the volcanically formed **Crater Highlands**, which are dotted with deep volcanic craters. The best known, **Ngorongoro** is the world's largest intact caldera and a natural wildlife reserve with few peers. **Ngorongoro** safari tours offer your best chance in Tanzania of spotting all the **Big Five (Lion, Leopard, Elephant, Buffalo and Black Rhino)** in one game drive. The crater is also notable for the spectacularly scenic combination of the verdant plains of the lake-studded crater floor and imposing 600m-/1,968ft-high cliffs that enclose it on all sides.

In the evening, the group reconvenes for an **awards presentation and a farewell dinner**. Raise your glasses, toast to the incredible experiences shared, and cherish the memories created during this magical adventure.

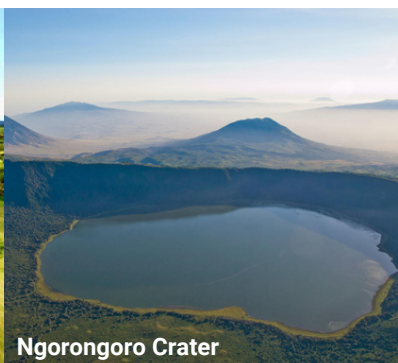

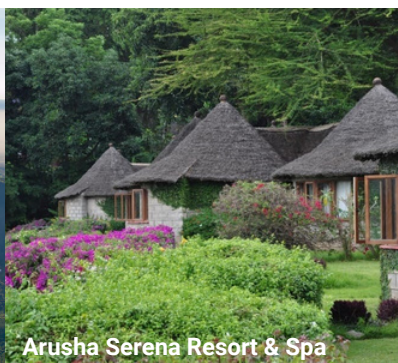
